Kindergarten Uniform

- The smock is worn at all times over comfortable personal clothing.
- For physical education (2 classes per week):
 - Navy shorts or pants
 - Grey or white T-shirt
 - Zip-up hoodie (Kangourou)
 - Multi-sport shoes (laced or not) with non-marking soles
- The art class smock is mandatory (available at Unimage or another store)
- Shoe bag (available at Unimage or another store)

Physical Education Uniform

- Navy shorts (allowed: August, September, May, June, and at the gym)
- Grey or white T-shirt
- Multi-sport shoes (either style) with non-marking soles
 - Laced or not (Grade 1) / Laced (Grades 2–6)
- Fleece-lined or navy nylon pants are still accepted, as well as the 50th-anniversary hoodie/T-shirt

Shoes and the physical education uniform (including the College hoodie and the "espadrille week" hoodie) must be worn only on physical education days (2 or 3 times per week) or during recess.

Please remember that it will be mandatory to label the family name on the back of the fleece sweatshirt with printed lettering. This service will be offered at the start of the year; more information to follow.

Miscellaneous

Hair: Clean, natural color. Discreet accessories, and hair tied back. Shaved patterns/designs are not permitted.

Jewelry: Discreet and limited in number. Preferably avoided. Smart watches are not permitted.

Makeup: Makeup, nail polish, and tattoos are not permitted.

Face: Everyone is required to keep their face uncovered.
